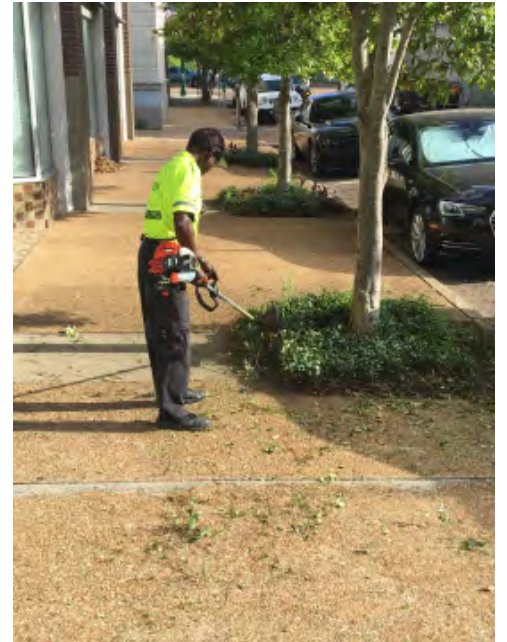

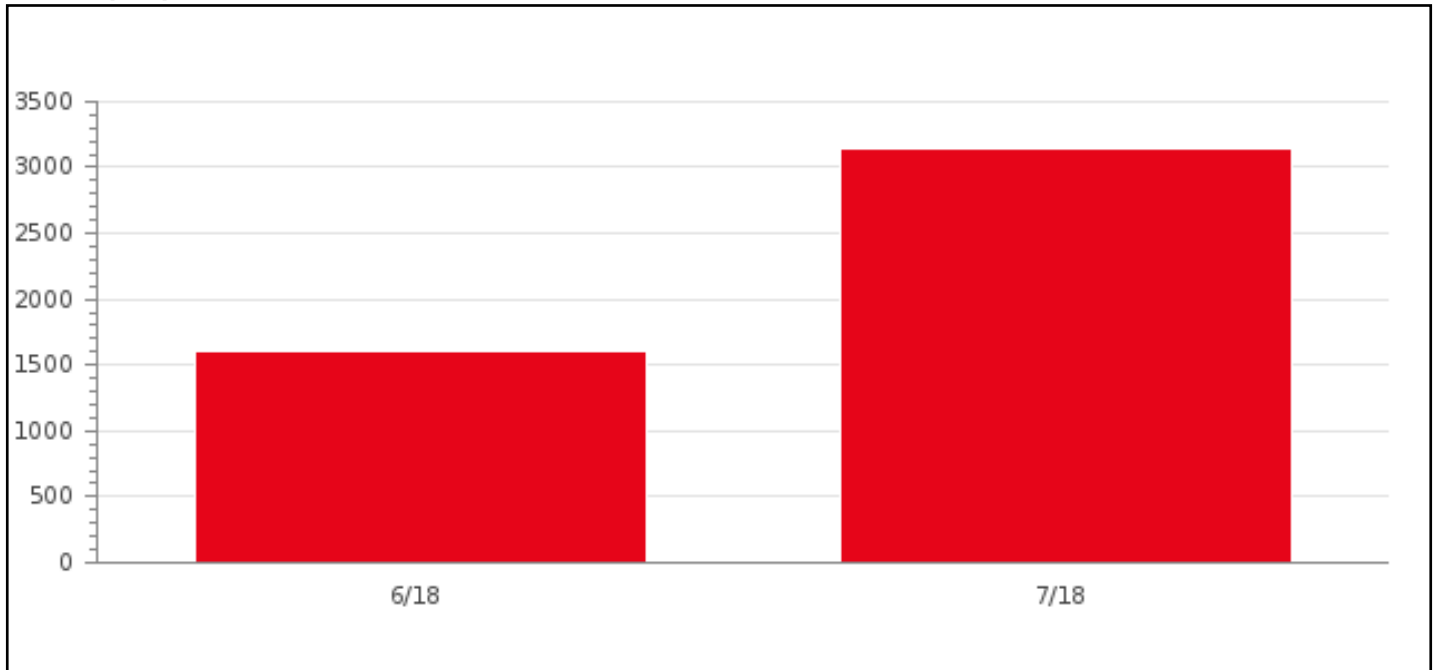

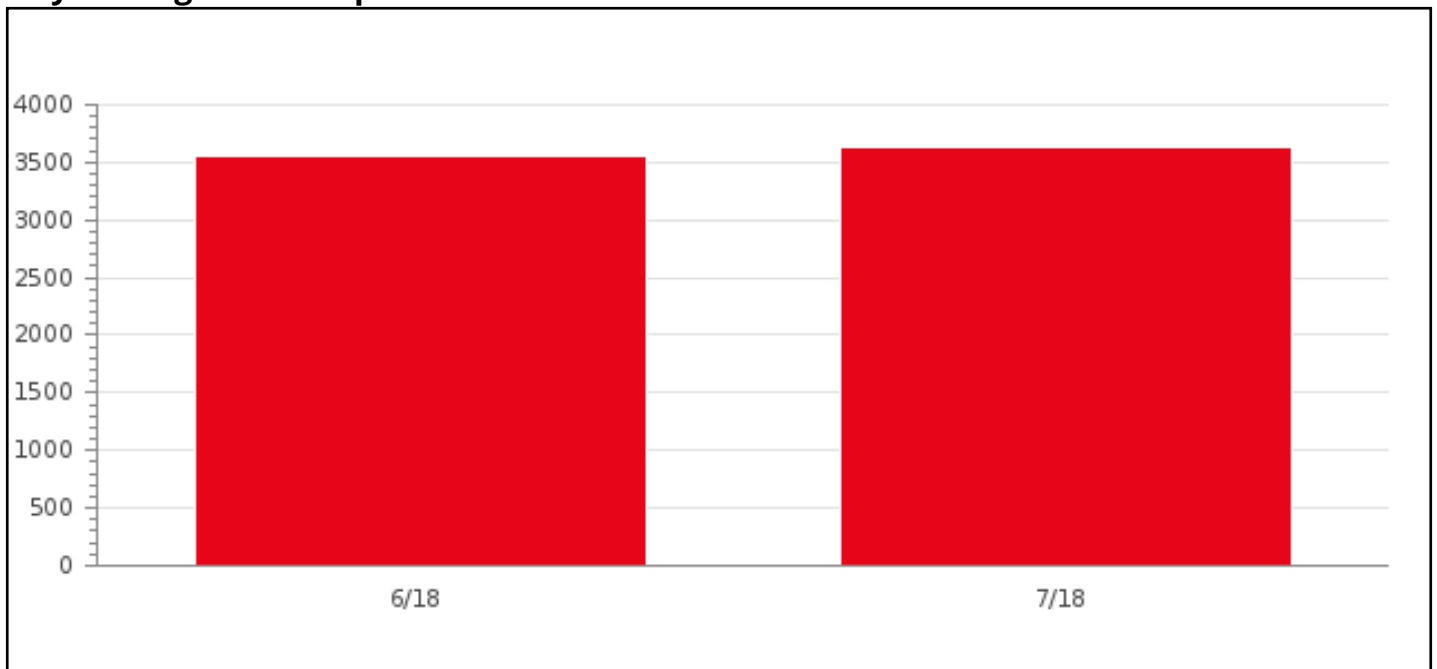
Cleaning Statistics

Trash (lbs) -- Month Vs. Month



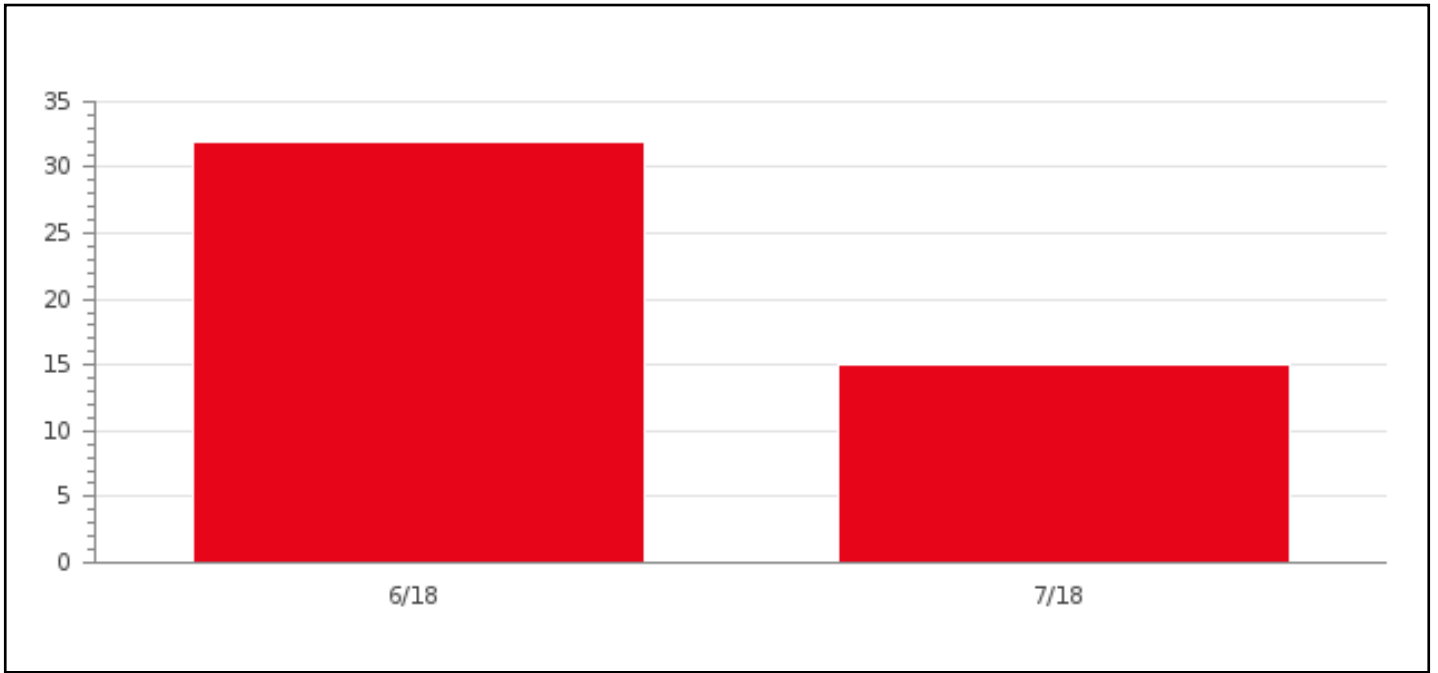
Notice there was an increase in trash collected for July 2018 vs June 2018; we attribute this to an increase in events throughout the district.

Notice there were no major changes.

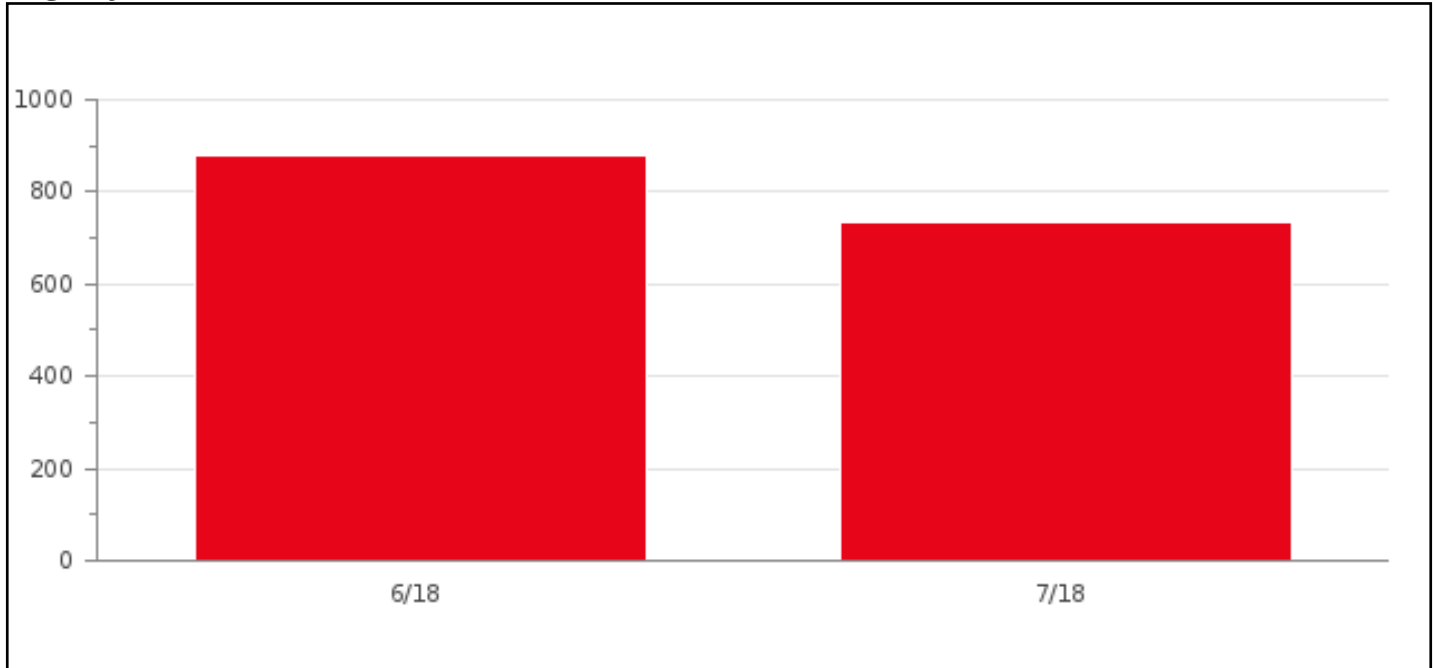
Graffiti - Removed -- Month Vs. Month



Notice there was a major decrease in graffiti removed for July 2018 vs June 2018; we attribute this to rapid removal upon being identified.

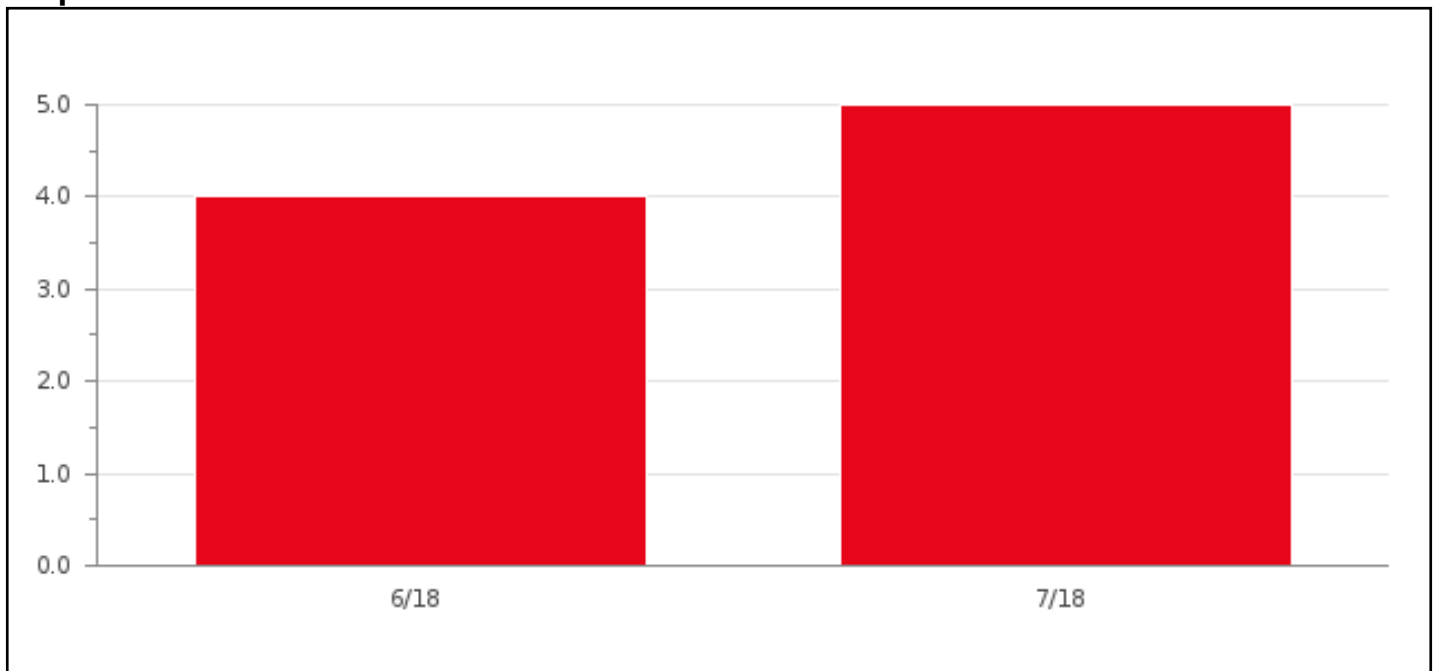
Safety Statistics

Segway Miles -- Month Vs. Month



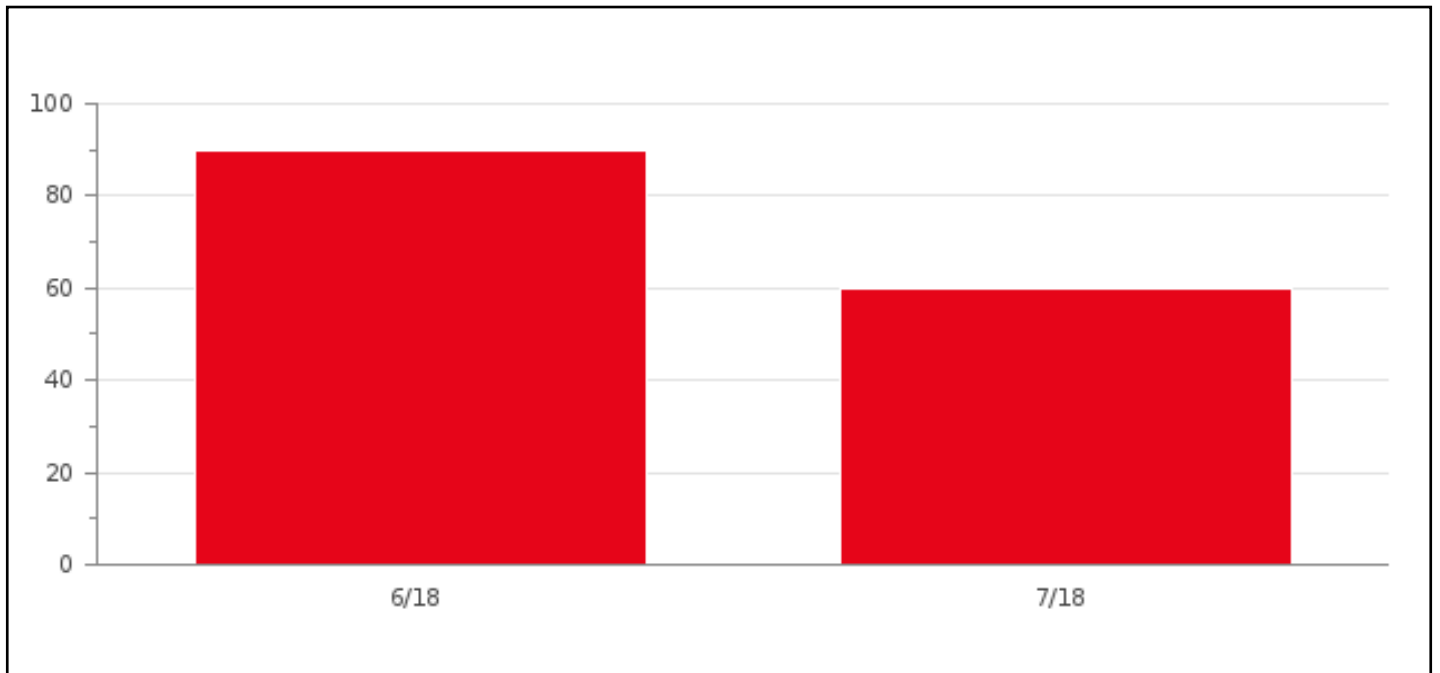
Notice there was a slight decrease in segway miles for July 2018 vs June 2018; we attribute this to inclement weather.
