# Highlights

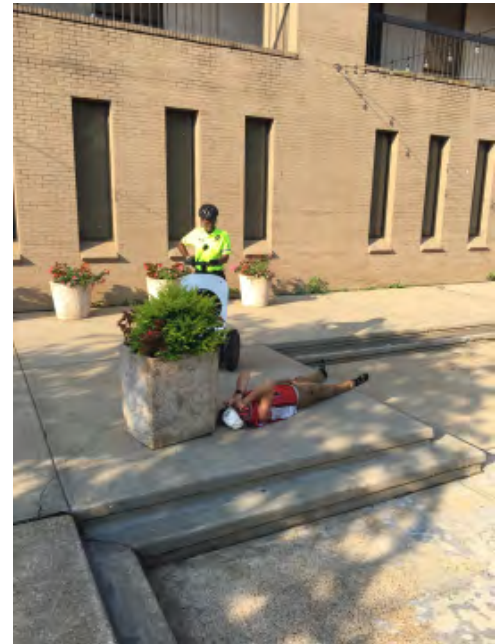
## Field Observations

- Ambassadors are noticing the homeless panhandling throughout the district then purchasing alcohol.

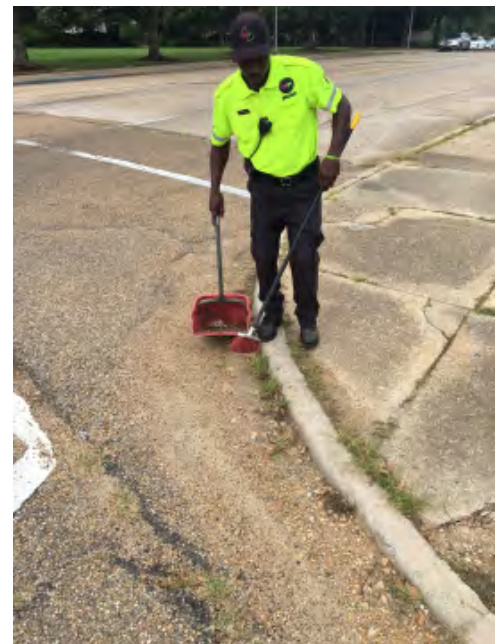
## Accomplishments

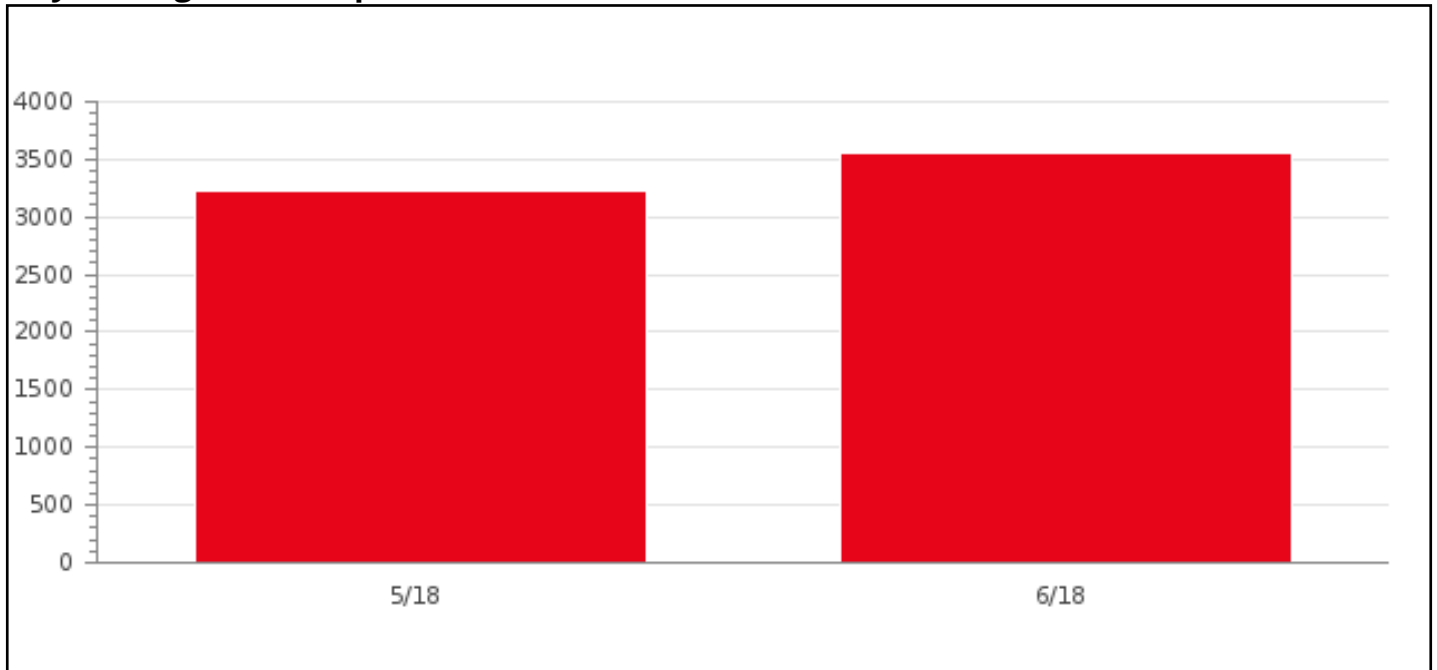

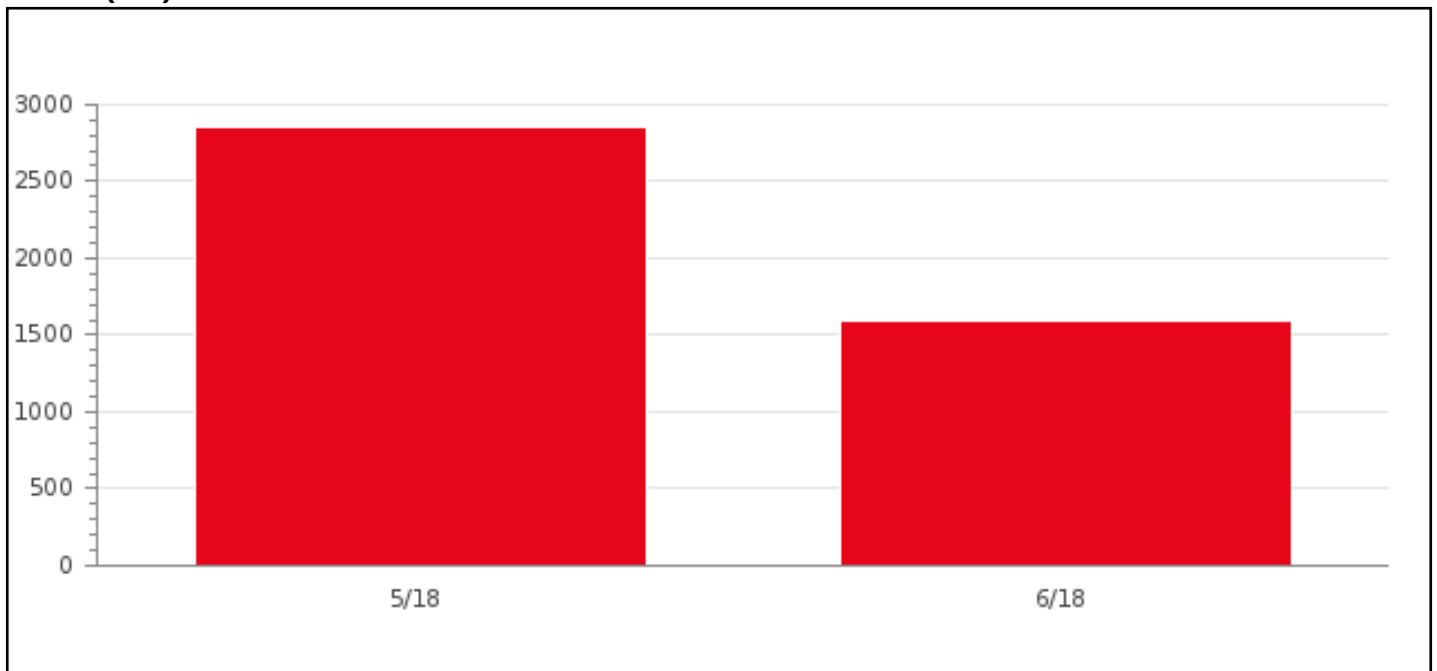
# Cleaning Statistics

## City Garbage Cans Emptied -- Month Vs. Month



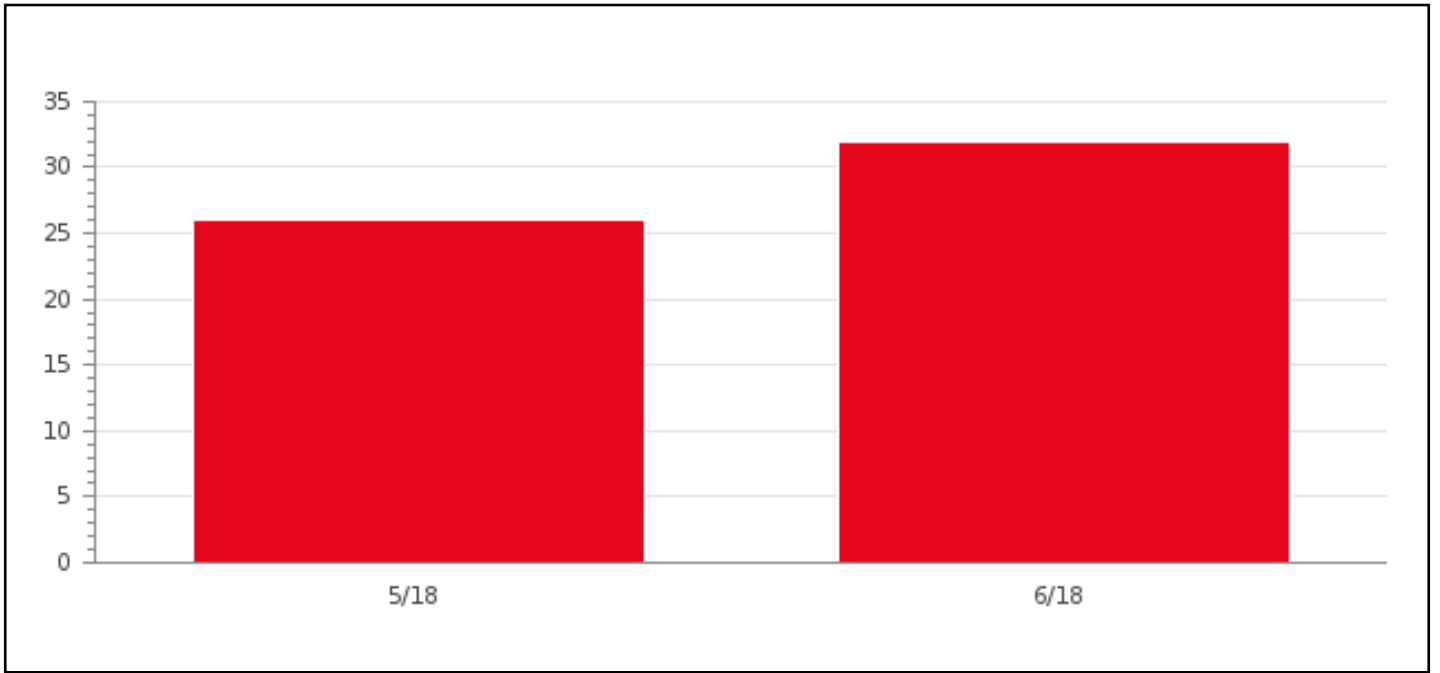
Notice there was a slight increase in city garbage cans emptied for June 2018 vs May 2018; we attribute this to more pedestrian foot traffic throughout the district.

Notice there was decrease in trash collected for June 2018 vs May 2018; we attribute this to less events held throughout the district.

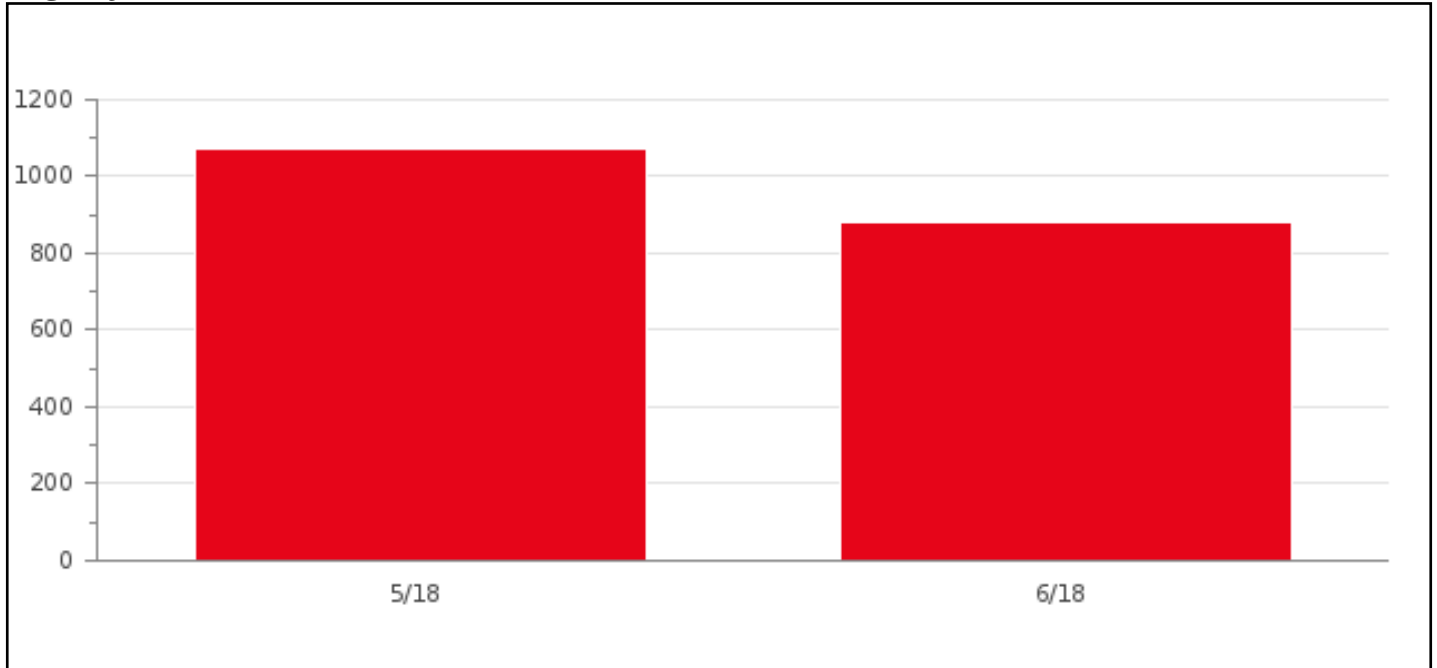
## Graffiti - Removed -- Month Vs. Month



Notice there was an increase in graffiti removed for June 2018 vs May 2018; we attribute this to campaign signs being placed throughout the district.

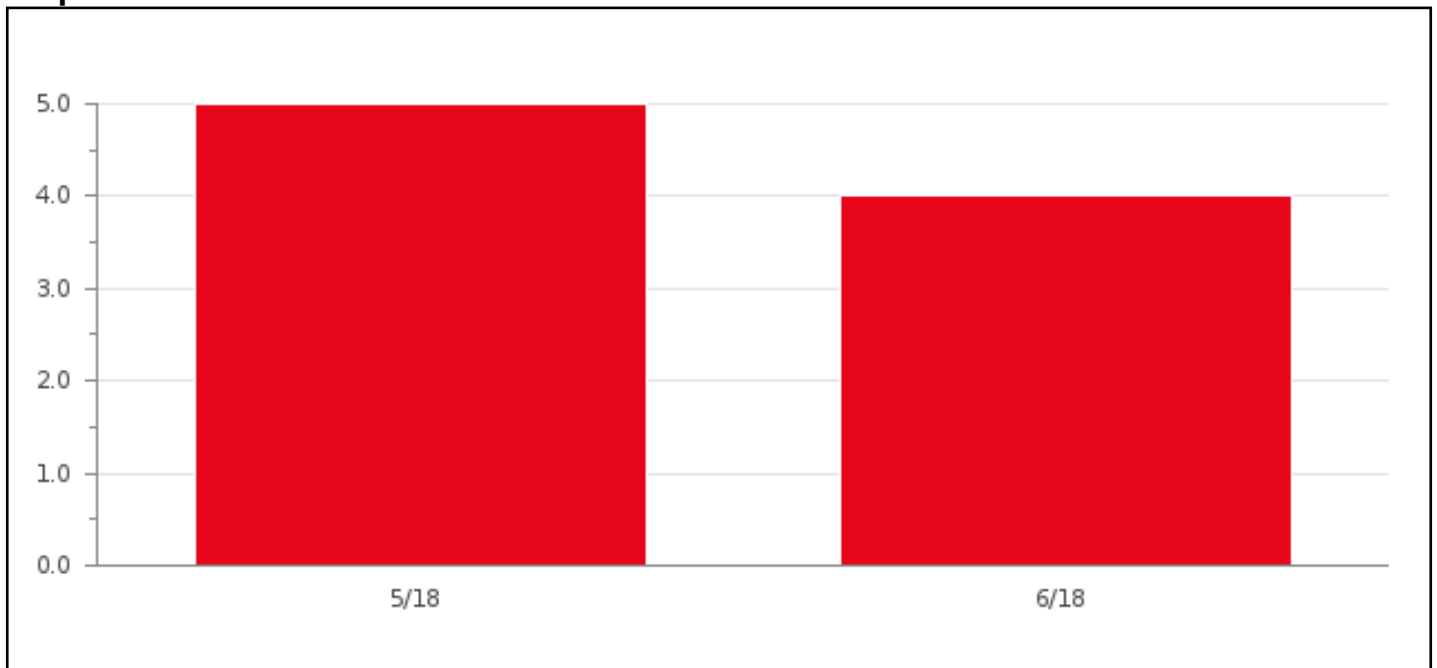
# Safety Statistics

## Segway Miles -- Month Vs. Month



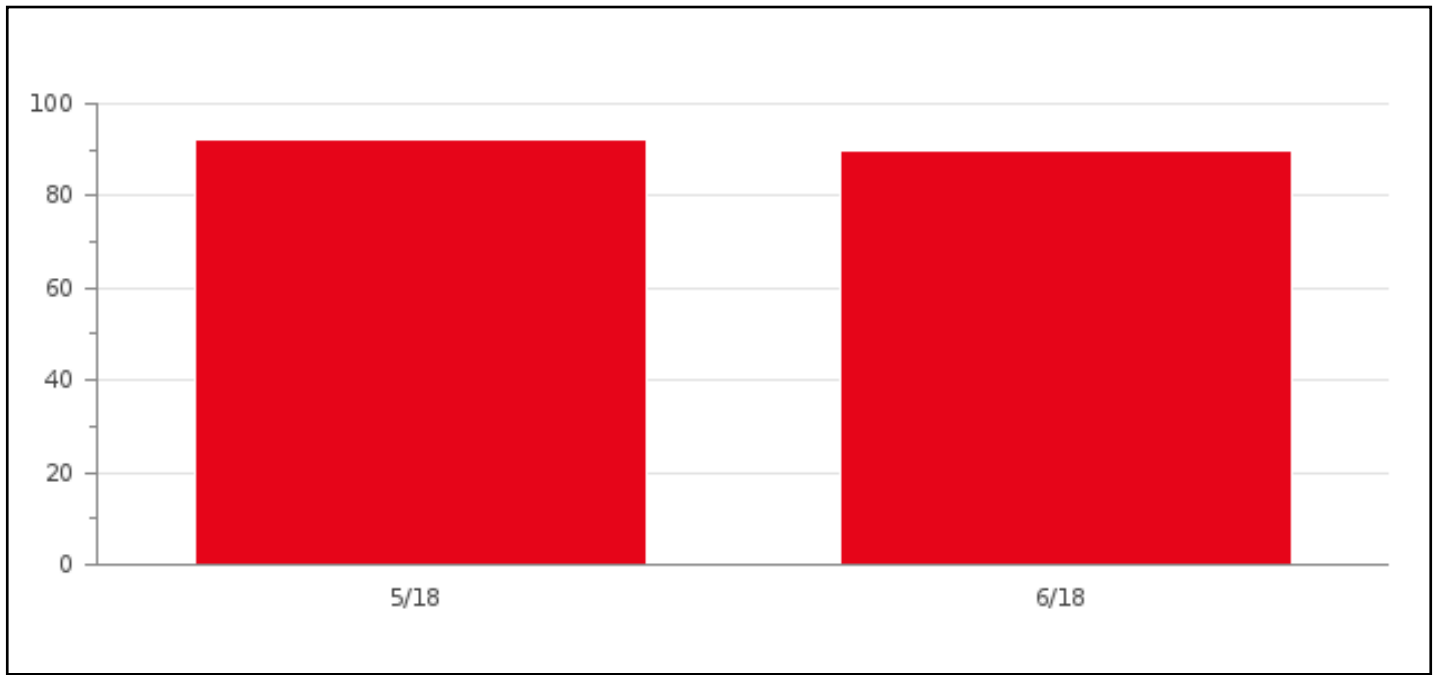
Notice there was a decrease in segway miles for June 2018 vs May 2018; we attribute this to inclement weather.
