# Highlights

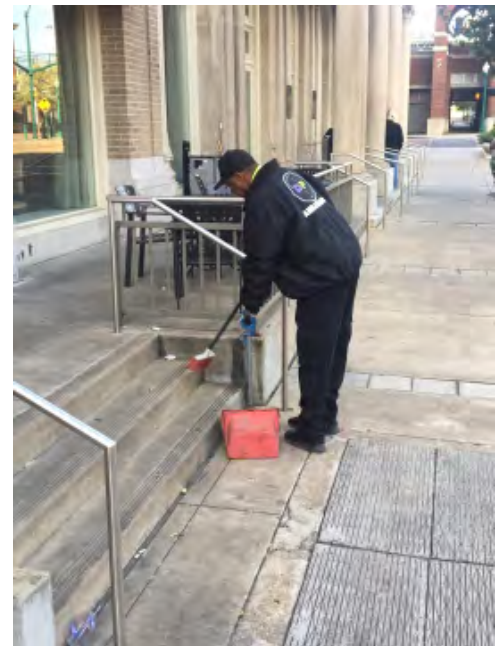
## Field Observations

- We are beginning to receive calls from pedestrians for escort services during the evening hours after work.

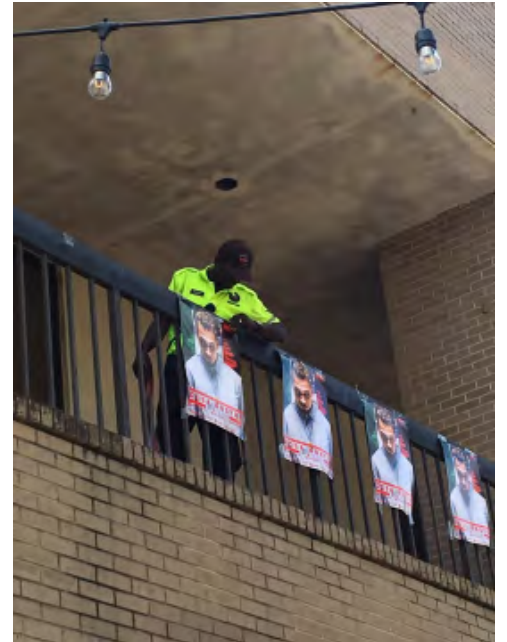

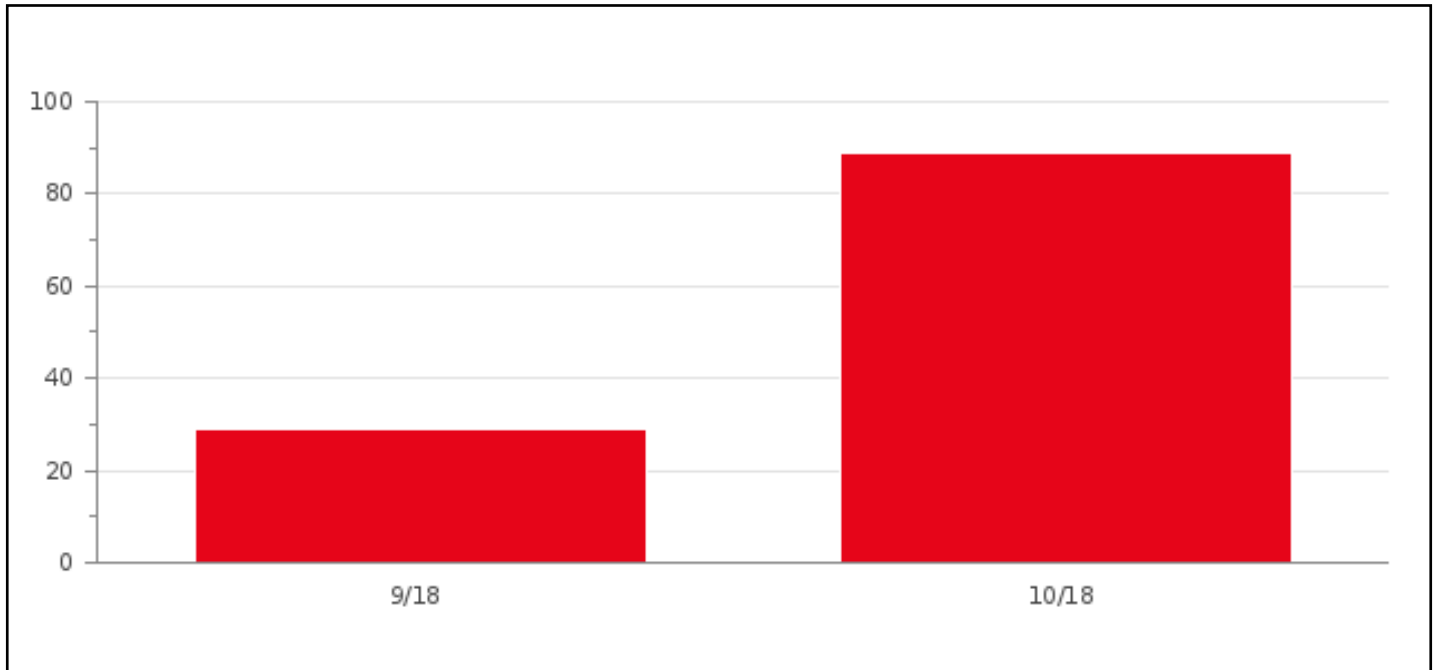

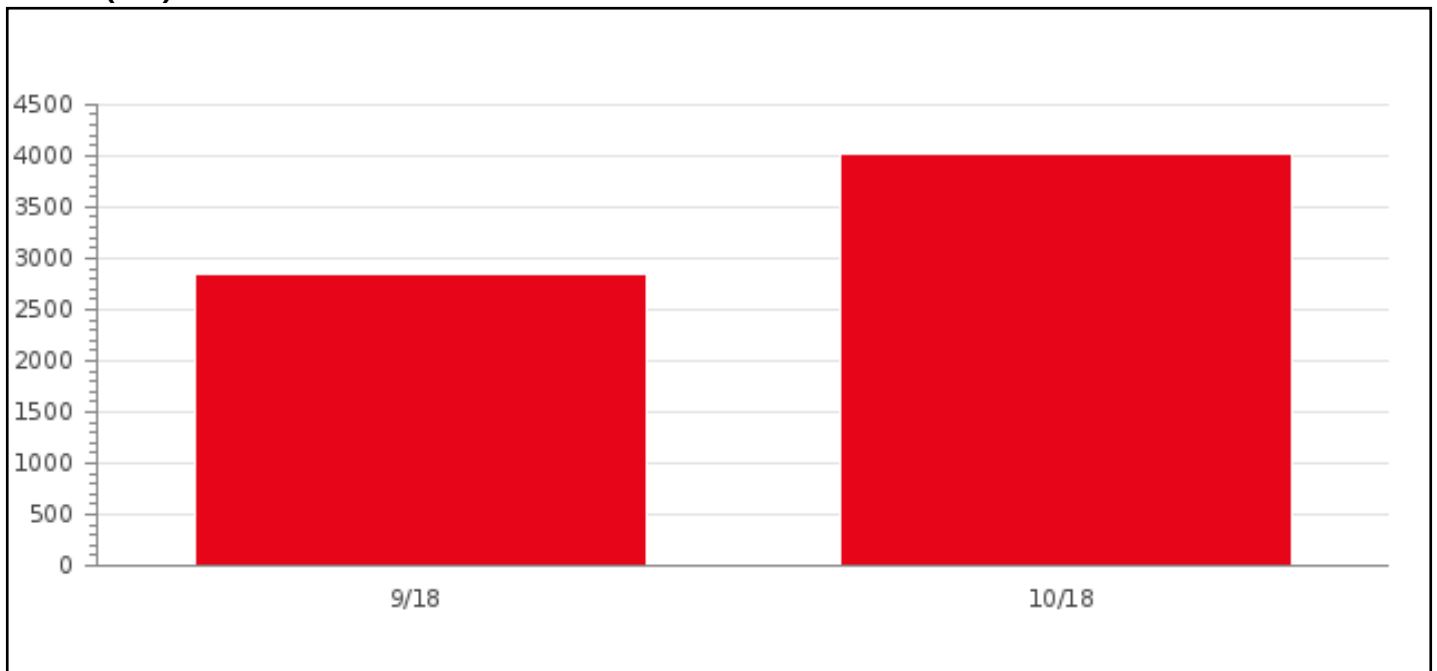
# Cleaning Statistics

## Graffiti - Removed -- Month Vs. Month



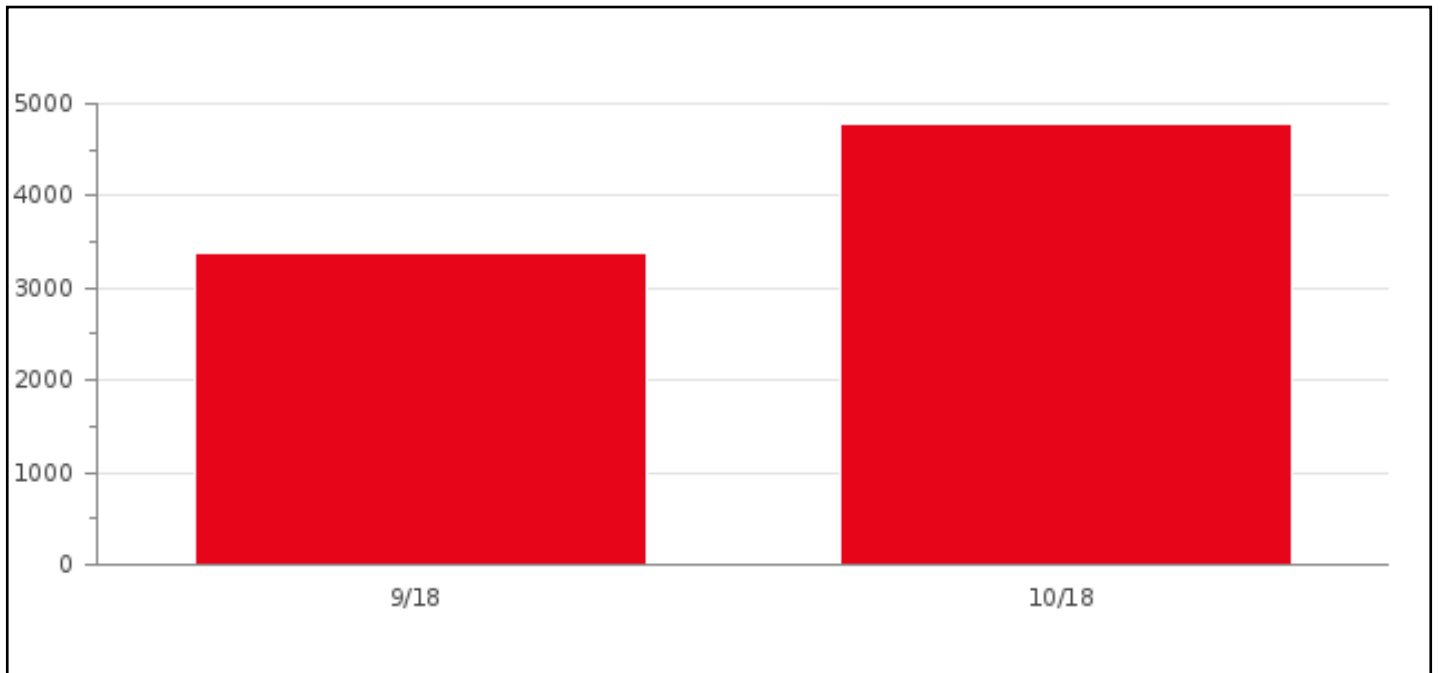
Notice there was an increase in graffiti removed for Oct 2018 vs. Sept 2018; we attribute this to campaign signs and posters placed throughout the district.

Notice there was an increase in trash collected for Oct 2018 vs. Sept 2018; we attribute this to an increase in events held throughout the district.

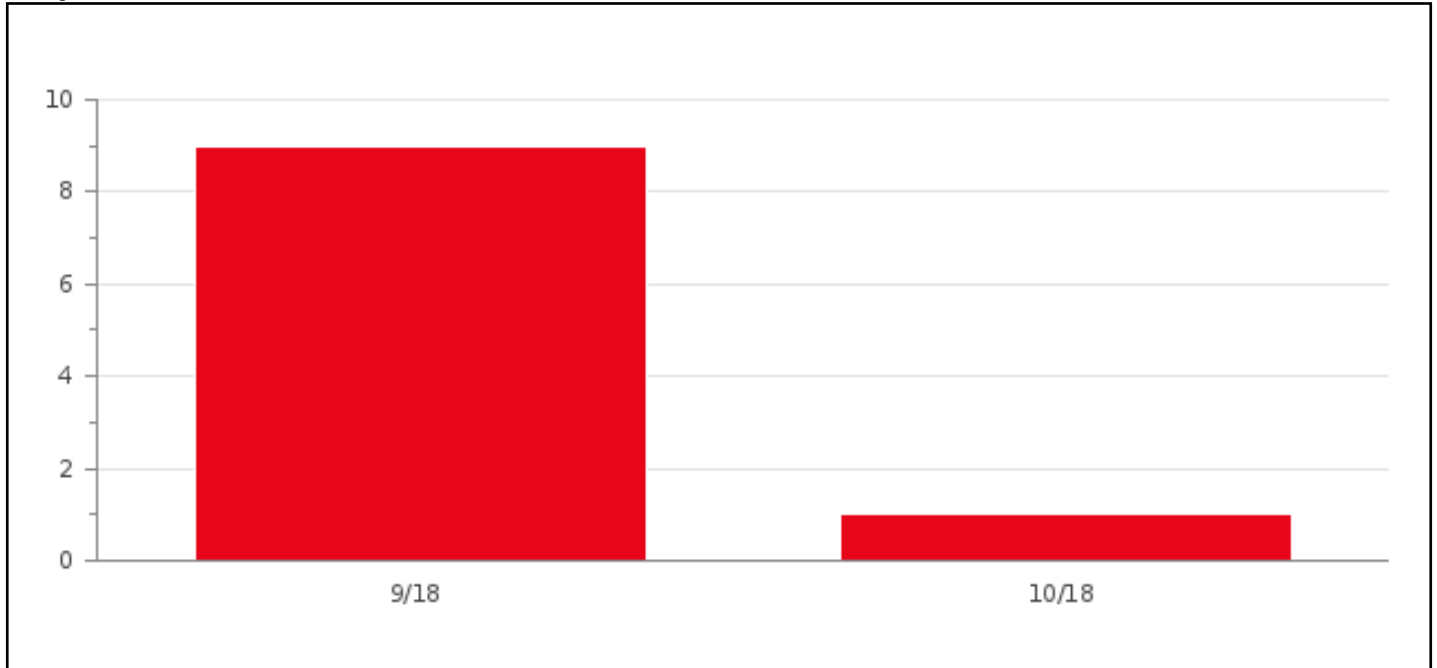
## City Garbage Cans Emptied -- Month Vs. Month

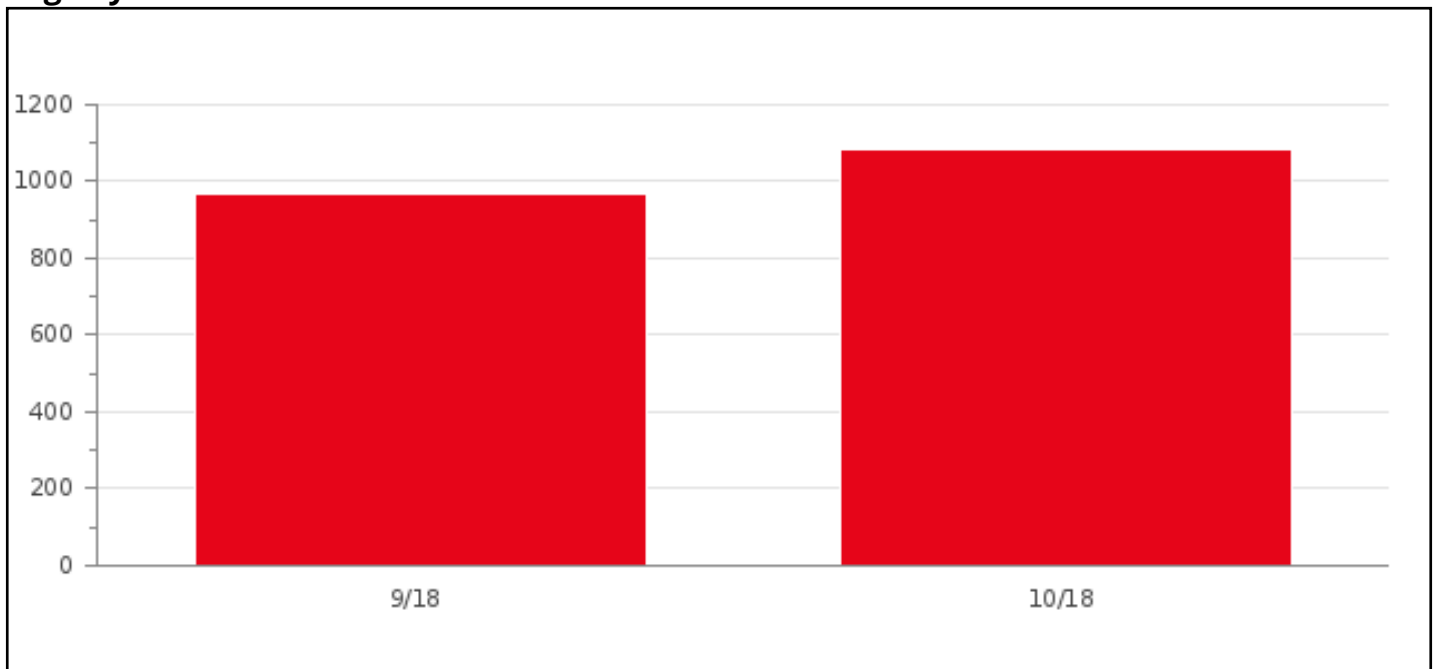
# Safety Statistics

## Request for Police / Fire / EMS / Assistance -- Month Vs. Month



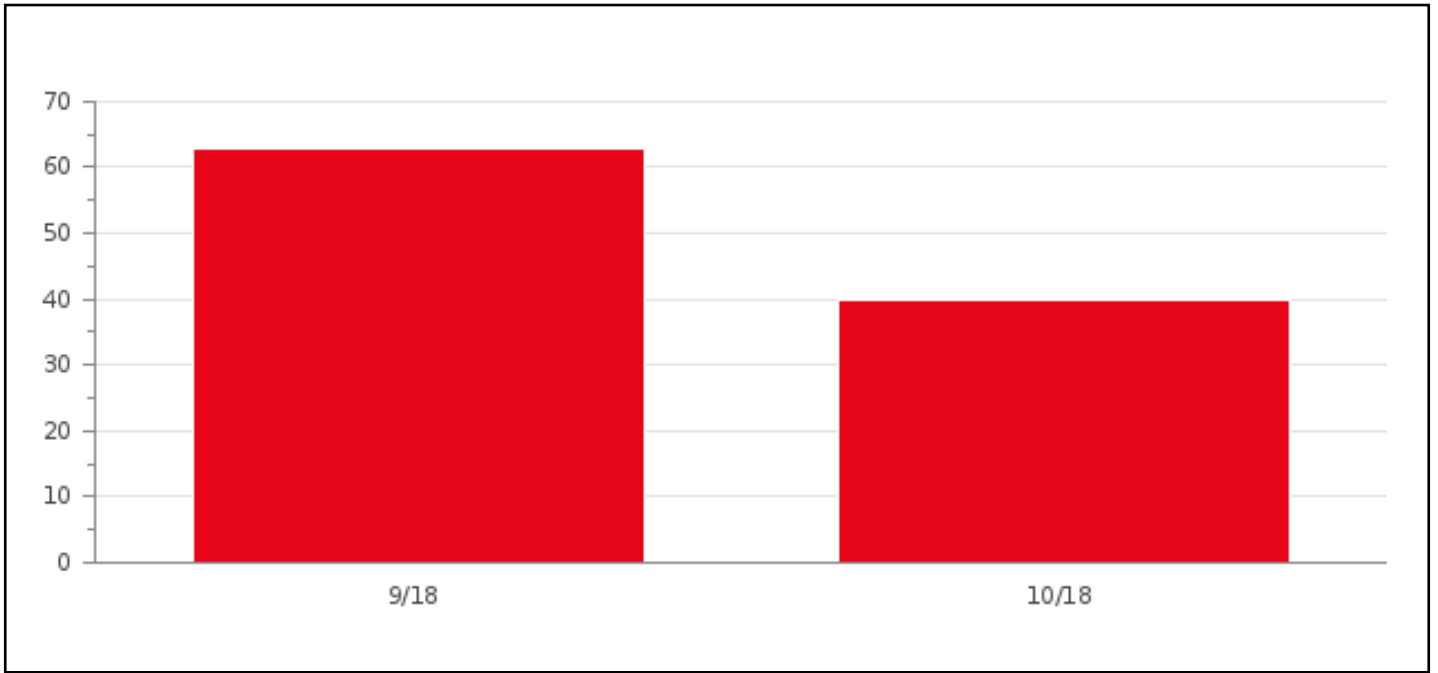
Notice there was a decrease in request for police for Oct 2018 vs. Sept 2018; we attribute this to increased police presence throughout the district.
