Highlights

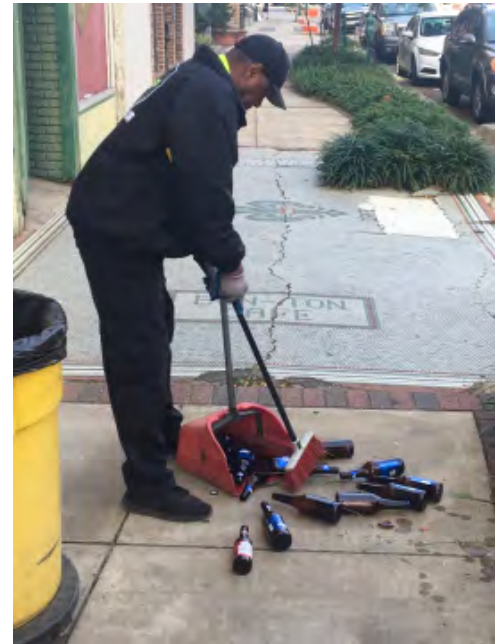
Field Observations

- Ambassadors are seeing an increase in windows being broken from abandoned buildings throughout the district.

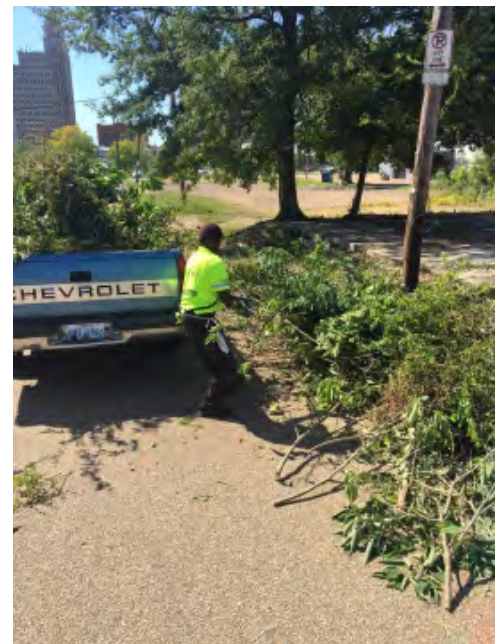

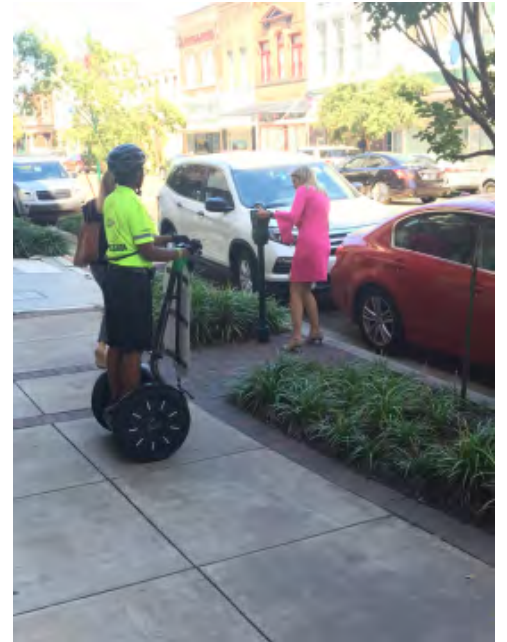

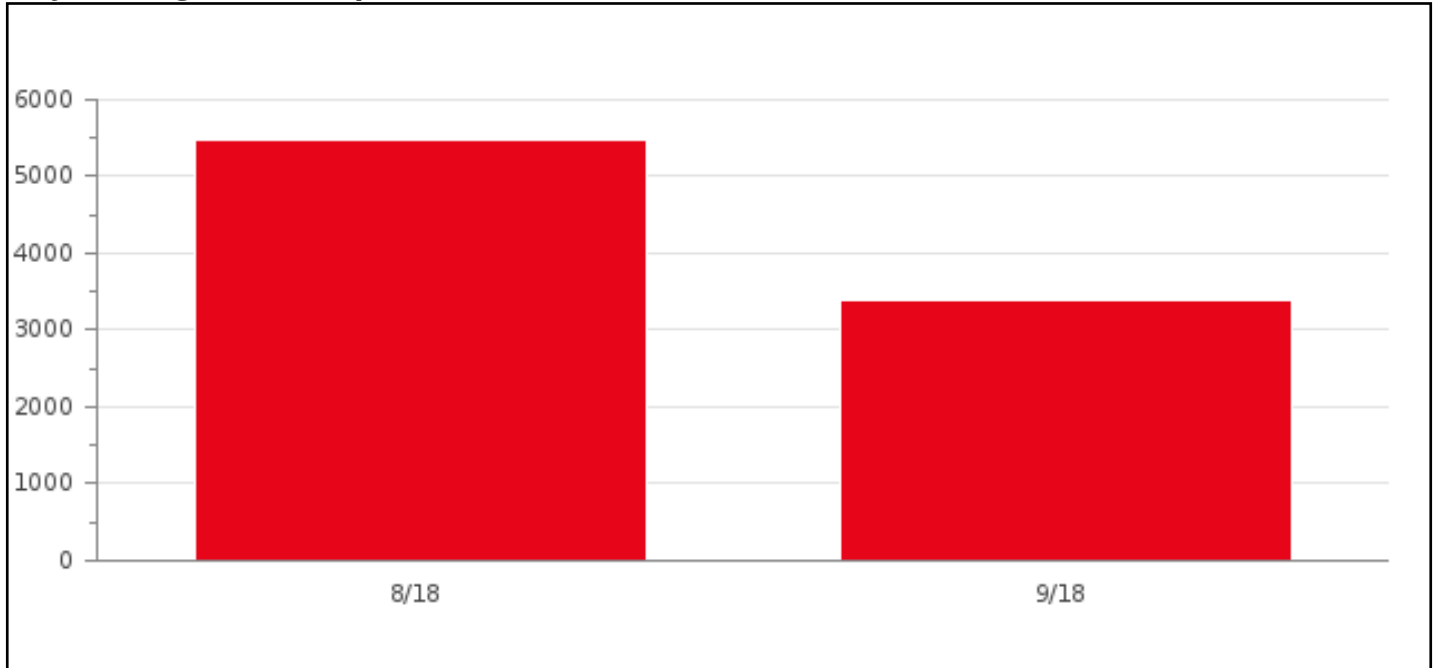

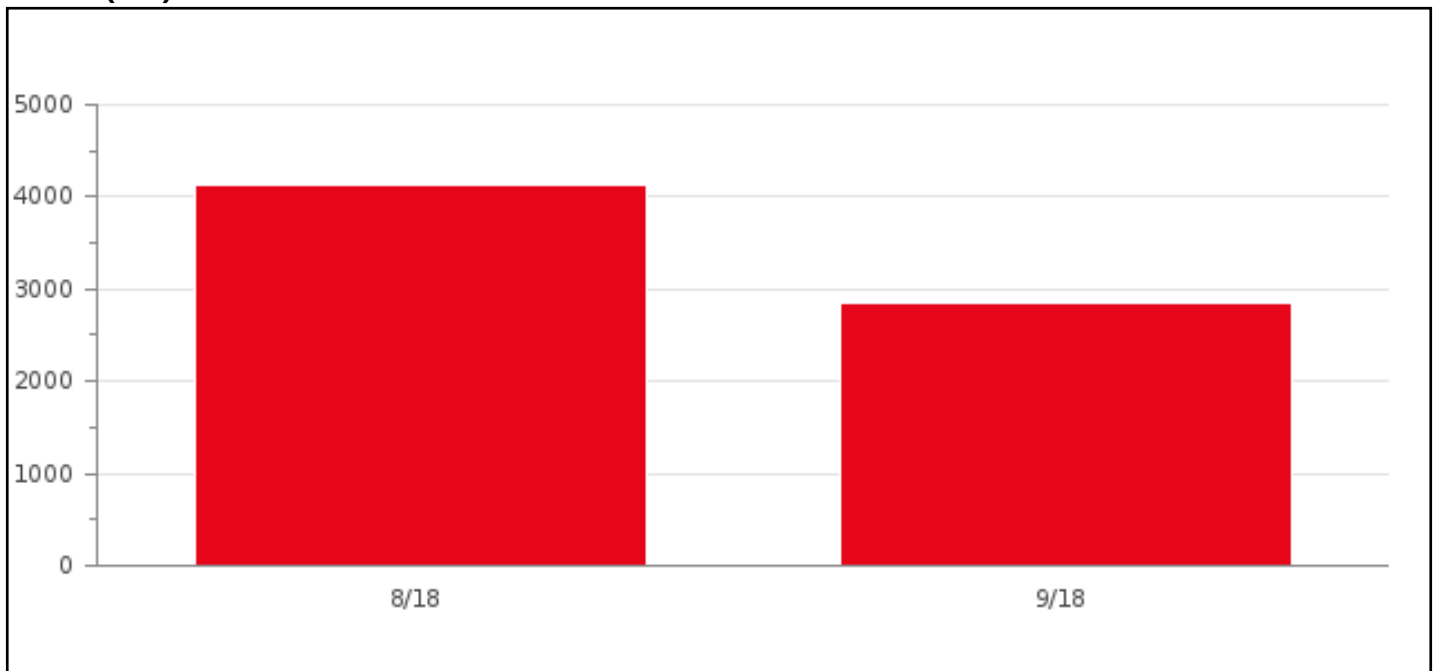
Cleaning Statistics

City Garbage Cans Emptied -- Month Vs. Month



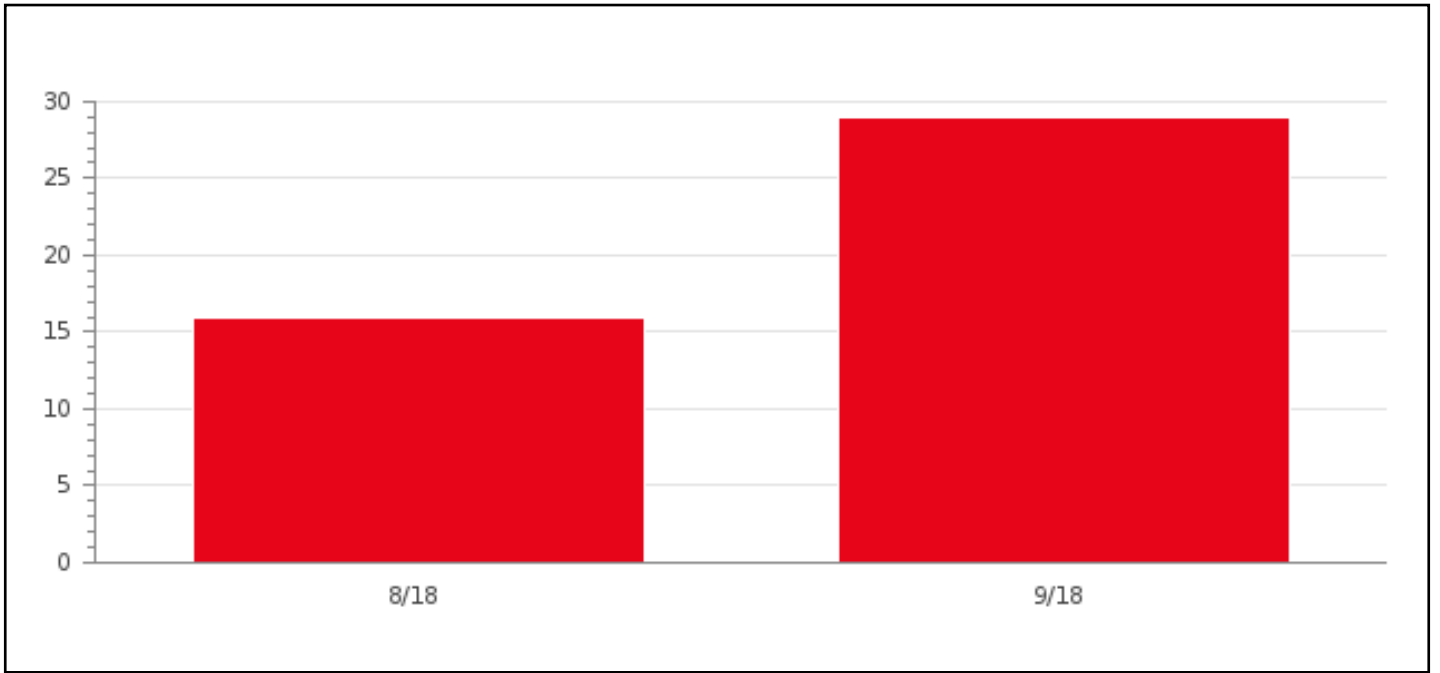
Notice there was a decrease in city garbage cans emptied for September 2018 vs August 2018; we attribute this to less foot traffic throughout the district.

Notice there was a decrease in trash collected for September 2018 vs August 2018; we attribute this to less events throughout the district.

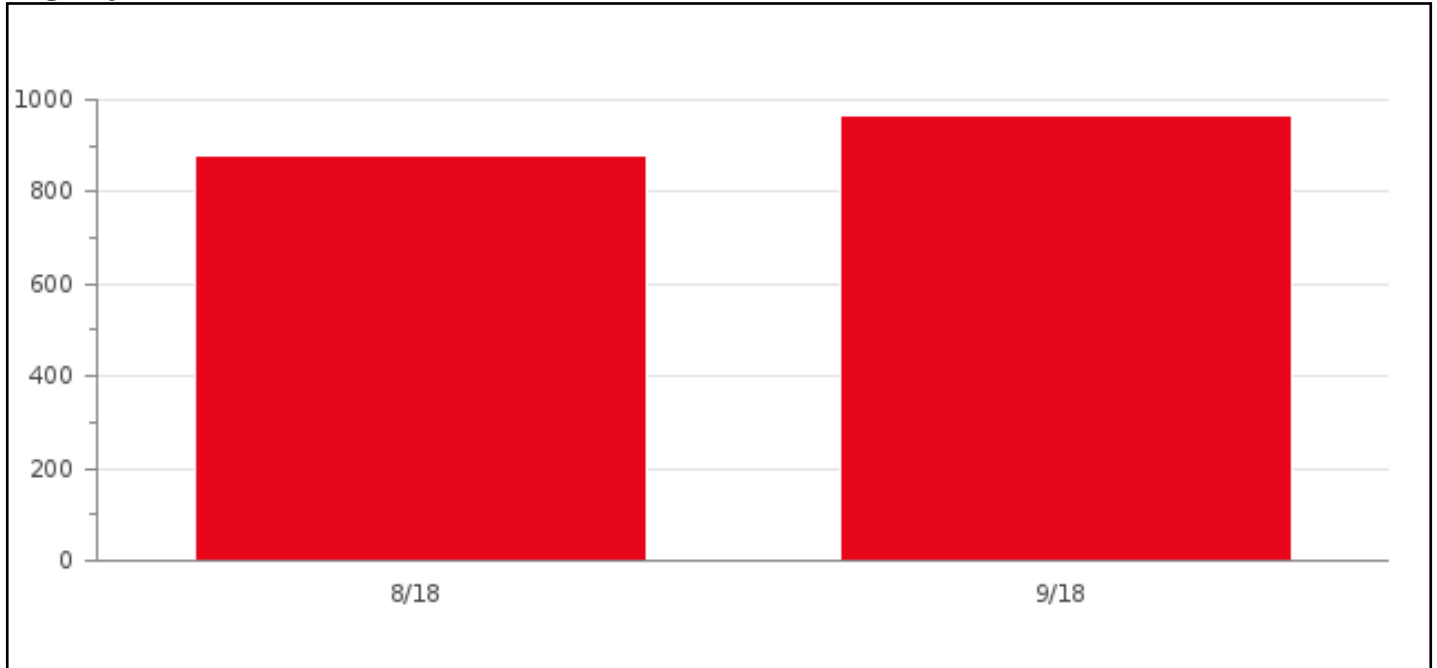
Graffiti - Removed -- Month Vs. Month



Notice there was an increase in graffiti removed for September 2018 vs August 2018; we attribute this to campaign signs and posters throughout the district.

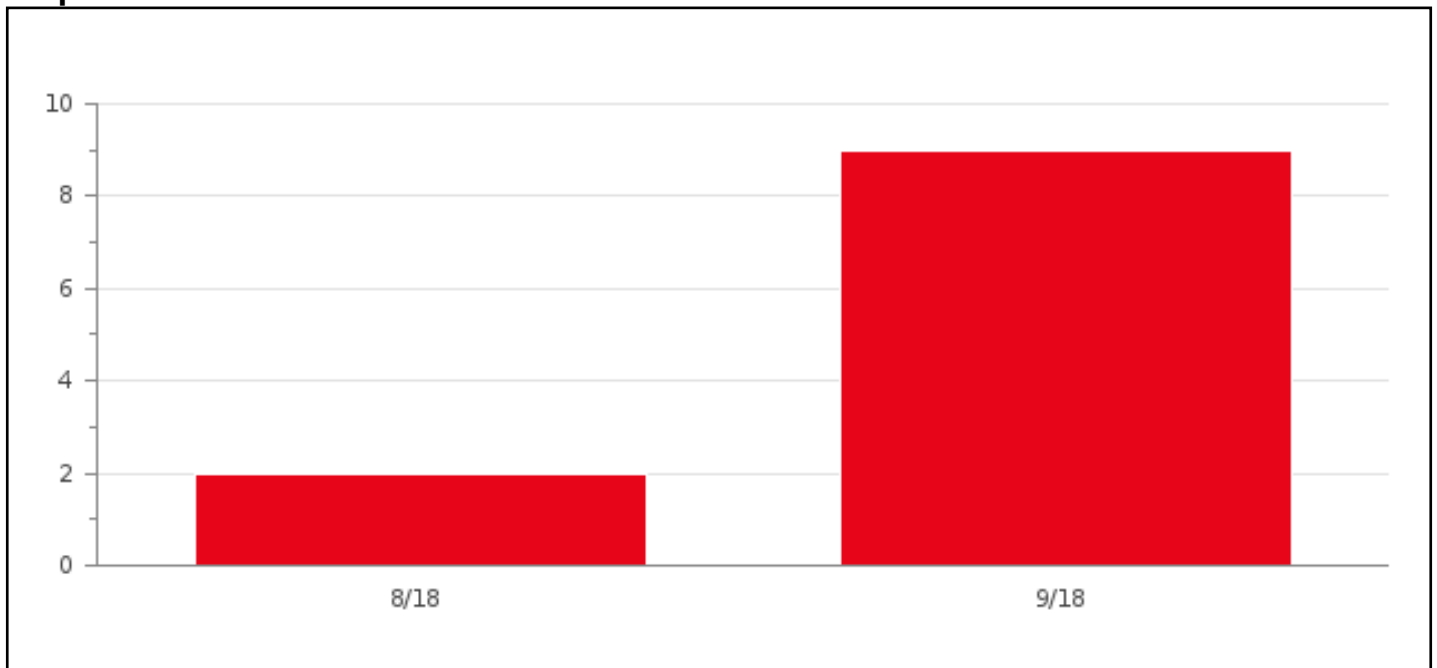
Safety Statistics

Segway Miles -- Month Vs. Month



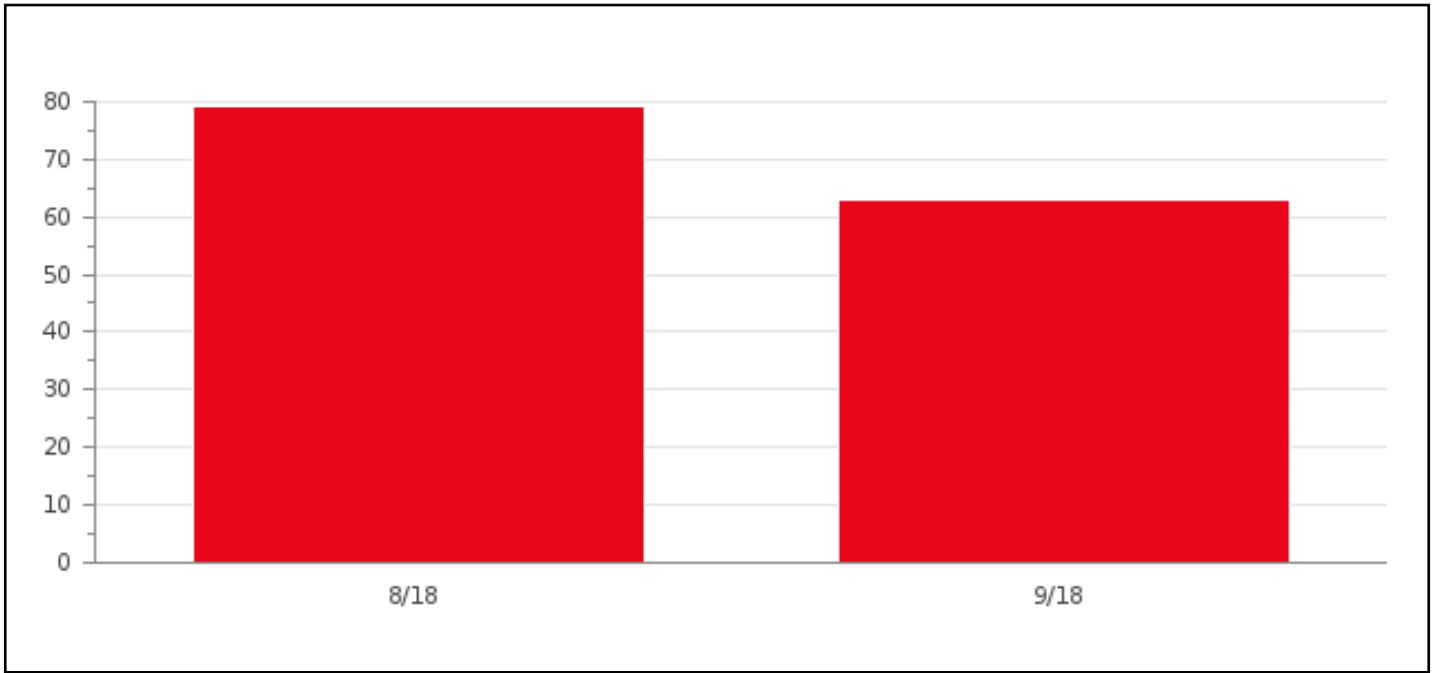
Notice there was an increase in September 2018 vs August 2018; we attribute this to less inclement weather.
